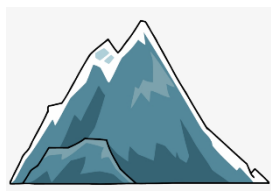


## Patient Advocate Foundation Scholarship for Survivors - \$3000

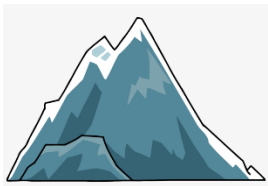


## Create a greeting Card Contest - \$10,000

### **Lockheed Martin Vocational Scholarship - \$6600**

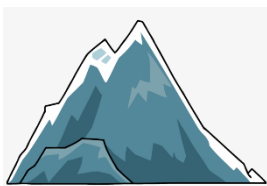
**March 11**

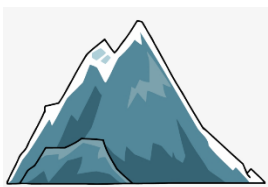


### **The Real Impact Contest – \$500, \$1500U**

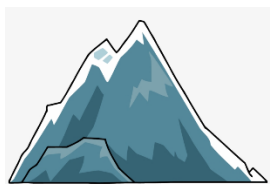


### **Hannah Warburton Resilience Award - \$500**

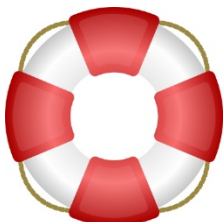


### **Lifeline for Youth Scholarship - \$1000**
