TELEVISION BROADCASTING 2

This course is designed to provide students with the advanced knowledge and skills related to the television broadcasting industry. This course includes instruction and hands-on assignments in the following areas: camera operation, audio systems, lighting systems, pre-production, studio operations, control room operations, visual effects and graphics, and copyright laws.

- Pre-Production: Students will demonstrate proper pre-production tasks.
- Camera: Students will be able to demonstrate knowledge to the correct operation of the camera.
- Audio: Students will be able to understand and demonstrate proper use of audio systems.
- Lighting: Students will demonstrate proper use of lighting systems.
- Editing: Students will demonstrate proper post-production techniques.
- Live Broadcast: Students will produce multiple broadcasts.
- Understand and practice copyright laws, ethics, and legal issues as it relates to the broadcasting industry.
